Cathedral to host service celebrating life and witness of Desmond Tutu

The diocesan community is invited to join in giving thanks for the life and witness of the late **Archbishop Desmond Tutu** on **Wednesday, Feb. 2 at 6 p.m.**

The livestreamed service of Holy Eucharist will be held at the Cathedral Church of St. Paul in Boston. Bishop Alan M. Gates and Bishop Gayle E. Harris will co-preside, and a sermon will be offered by the Rev. Noble Scheepers, co-chair of the diocesan Racial Justice Commission, who was mentored by and worked with Tutu.

Because of COVID-19 protocols, in-person attendance will be limited to 50. The livestream will be available to all via the [cathedral's website](#) and [YouTube channel](#).

In preparation for the Feb. 2 service, the cathedral invites brief personal remembrances, thanksgivings and tributes to Tutu, as well as scans of photographs from encounters with him, for inclusion in a wall of tribute in the cathedral sanctuary.

It has been mentioned that Archbishop Tutu visited St. Andrew's (mid-1980s?) to preside over a confirmation service. **If anyone has any pictures or other materials from that visit, please scan/send them to sean.glennon22@gmail.com** as soon as possible to be included in an upcoming e-news edition.
