His ministry guided him throughout his life and career, having a diverse career in ministry, teaching, corporate America, city government and philanthropy. A collegiate swimmer for Princeton, he continued to swim every day, getting up at 4:30 AM to swim a mile before the day began. His life was filled with his love of family, music and travel. A life well lived, devoted to helping others, he is missed.
